Robert was born on April 10, 1919, and joined the United States Army February 6, 1942, Company C, 4th Engineer Combat Battalion, ranking to Sergeant. Robert served in several campaigns during his military career, the Normandy Invasion, European African Middle Eastern, Northern France, Rhineland and Ardennes.

He was awarded many commendations including the Purple Heart with Oak Leaf Cluster, Good Conduct Medal, Distinguished Unit Badge, European African Middle Eastern Service Medal with 4 Bronze Stars, and 1 Arrowhead. Robert left the Army on September 11, 1945.

Robert married Joyce Haskell in 1956, raising 3 children, Stephanie, Keith and Terry in their home at 212 Chestnut Street, Mt Holly Springs.

Robert went to work for the Mt Holly Springs Post Office as their first mail carrier in April 1953, retiring in 1981 with 28 years of service.

Robert served as an assistant coach for the Mt Holly Little League, a past Commander and member of the VFW Post #7343, a member of the Eagles #1299 and a member of the Mt Holly Springs Fish & Game. Robert passed away on September 16, 1998, at age 79.
