

Douglas Landis was born October 23, 1959, to parents Robert and Darlene Landis, he grew up in Mt Holly Springs on Hill Street and was one of the "Hill Street" kids.

He graduated in 1977 from Carlisle High School, and after graduation enlisted in the United States Air Force, serving most of his military career at Ellsworth AFB in Rapid City, South Dakota. Doug was a Staff Sergeant working as a Field Missile Maintenance Shop & Power, Refrigeration & Electrical Shop Technician, and was Honorably Discharged from the Air Force after about 9 years of service.

Doug returned to Mt Holly Springs after serving his country and found work in heating and air conditioning. Doug would later open his own HVAC company. He served his community by being on the MHS Borough Water Authority for a few years. Doug was also a member of the American Legion Post 674, in Mt Holly.

Doug married Kathy (Weary) "the girl who grew up across the street" in March 1986, they raised two boys Russ and Jeff. Doug spent his rare time taking his family to eat ice cream at Twirly Top, enjoying woodworking and gaming on his computer.

Doug died from a short aggressive battle with esophageal cancer in July 2016 at the age of 56.
