

Joseph N Still was born in Halifax, Pa in 1928, in the ancestral home of the Still family since 1810. He attended high school at the Harrisburg Academy. Joseph joined the United States Army in December 1946 at the age of 18, serving as a Technician 4th Class. He was deployed to Korea, nearly dying from complications when he developed pneumonia while stationed there.

Joseph met and married Dorothy Foreman of Carlisle, together they had a daughter Pamela, 2 sons Stephen and Kenneth.

Joseph spent his career as an electronics technical writer, which included jobs all over the United States, (Pennsylvania, Iowa, Washington, Georgia, and Maryland) along with overseas assignments. He retired from Westinghouse in Maryland in 2008 and his wife Dorothy previously retired from Mobil Oil.

Dorothy returned to Mt Holly Springs, to live with daughter Pam in her historic stone house, and eventually Joseph also relocated here when he retired in 2008. The well-traveled couple found Mt Holly Springs a place of quiet beauty and solitude and wanted to spend their remaining years here in the community, Joseph passed away in 2022.
