

Ross Richwine was born in the Carlisle Hospital on July 8, 1933, to parents Ross and Lucy (Souder), he grew up in Mt. Holly Springs along with his sister Kathryn (Rynard). Ross attended and graduated from Carlisle High School, Class of 1950. In July 1953, Ross enlisted in the United States Army as a diesel mechanic until 1955, after being discharged, he continued to serve another eight years in the Army Reserves.

Ross met and married Ann Bair in April 1961, and together they raised two sons J. Bradley and Douglas (who passed in 2016) in his hometown of Mt Holly Springs. Ross purchased rental properties in the community which he managed as their landlord.

Ross was active in the community and served as a member of the Mt Holly Springs Borough Authority. He had a passion for collecting antiques.
