RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT HOLLY SPRINGS BOROUGH COUNCIL,
COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR MEANINGFUL PUBLIC INPUT AT MEETINGS OF
COUNCIL AND COMMITTEES OF COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, Council is charged with promoting and protecting the rights of the citizens of the Borough of Mount Holly Springs to participate in a positive and constructive manner in the governing of the Borough, and

WHEREAS, as part of promoting and protecting such rights of the citizens of the Borough of Mount Holly Springs, Council recognizes the establishment of procedures for meaningful public input at the meetings of Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough of Mount Holly Springs, as follows;

At public meetings of Borough Council, the published agenda shall provide opportunities for citizen participation.

1. After the opening of the Borough Council session, following the approval of payment of bills and approval of the previous Council meeting minutes, opportunity shall be provided for those in attendance to be heard by the Council in the following manner and order.
 - a. Those who have, prior to the meeting and final preparation of the agenda, arranged to be heard.
 - b. Those who have arrived and before the start of the meeting, signed in with their name and address and concern.
 - c. All others who then request to be heard and are recognized by the Council President.
2. After Council announces an agenda item which may require a vote, those citizens present will have an opportunity to address the Council with their concerns and before any vote is taken by the Council.
3. During the old and new business section of the agenda, anyone present will have an opportunity to address Council on any item upon which Council may vote.


Nothing in this resolution shall be construed to prohibit Council from adopting reasonable rules and regulations addressing the matter of public comment or to limit, as necessary, public comment, in accordance with applicable law.

ANY other Resolution, or part of Resolution, conflicting with the provisions of this Resolution is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


