- A. **SINGLES: AGES 1-5** (MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT)
- B. **SINGLES: AGES 6-12** (Adult may walk with child, only the child is judged)
- C. **SINGLES: AGES 13-ADULT**
- D. **COUPLES** (Any TWO people)
- E. **GROUPS: (A. Walking or B. Motorized)**
- F. **SMALL FLOATS:**(Any Vehicle less than 10 feet)
- G. **LARGE FLOATS:** (Any vehicle over 10 FT and NOT exceeding 13 FT tall)
- H. **DECORATED SMALL LAWN TRACTOR OR ATV** (No more than two)
- I. **COMMERCIAL OR POLITICAL—ENTRY FEE OF 25.00—NOT JUDGED**

****Note:** ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLES CONSTITUTES AS A FLOAT. When measuring for a float do not include the length of the vehicle pulling the float.

*****Animals must have a pooper scooper accompanying them.**

Parade Rules and Guidelines

Registration will begin at 5:30 pm at Mt Holly Springs Elementary School Gym, on Mooreland Avenue.

Please sign-in and pick-up your- registration number BEFORE 6:30pm. Registration WILL CLOSE at 6:30pm.

You may utilize parking at the elementary school and Hilltop Church.

Follow parade organizers instructions, they have done this before.

All participants will be lined up in the order that you will be shown for the parade, If you are part of a group of vehicles riding together, you must arrive together and be staged together.

There will not be room to move vehicles around.

We encourage lights on floats and float spotters walking alongside during the parade.

SAFETY FIRST: Any motorized vehicle must be operated by a licensed/insured driver, in an entirely safe manner around people. SLOW SPEED...no gunning of engines..all wheels must remain on the ground..no burnouts..no loud horns..Essentially, nothing to distract the driver or other participants.

Children riding on floats/trailers must be supervised by adults walking alongside or riding on trailer/float.

All vehicles must continue at a slow, steady pace, and follow the direction of the parade organizers. **YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO EXIT YOUR VEHICLE/FLOAT DURING THE PARADE.**

All animals are the responsibility of the owner. Poop must be cleared as it falls to the ground and discarded properly.

Music containing offensive or vulgar language and offensive displays will NOT BE ALLOWED OR TOLERATED.

You are allowed to distribute candy, bead necklaces and other happiness AWAY from parade participants and not endangering spectators. Please no literature such as brochures, flyers, etc...as these usually end up on the streets after the parade is over.

THERE WILL BE NO RAINOUT DATE.
