

**Mt. Holly Springs Borough Council Committee
Meeting Minutes- October 28, 2021**

Call to Order – Mr. Collins called the committee meeting of the Borough Council to order at 6:30 p.m. and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Allow the Borough Manager to hire an attorney to assist in writing a new agreement for wastewater treatment for South Middleton Township. A motion was made by Sherry Boyles and seconded by Cathy Neff. All members voted yes.

Adjourn – Deborah Halpin-Brophy made a motion to adjourn that was seconded by Cindy Goshorn. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
